
Monk Season One



DISC ONE:

- 1. Mr. Monk and the Candidate: In Monk's stunning pilot episode, dirty politics come to light when a mayoral candidate's bodyguard is murdered at a campaign rally, and the suspects include the candidate's devious wife, his ambitious aide, and his dedicated volunteers.
- 2. Mr. Monk and the Psychic: There's definitely more than meets the eye when a shady psychic is the first one to discover a missing dead body, and Monk stages a "reading" in order to catch the killer.
- 3. Mr. Monk Meets Dale the Whale: Monk meets his match when the death of a murdered judge points to Dale "the Whale" Biederbeck, an 800-pound financier who can't fit through his doorway and hasn't left his bed in eleven years.

DISC TWO:

- 4. Mr. Goes to the Carnival: Monk's OCD reaches new heights when he must investigate the death of a police investigator on a Ferris wheel despite his dizzying sense of vertigo
- 5. Mr. Monk Goes to the Asylum: After a misunderstanding sends him to a psychiatric institute for forty-eight hours of observation, Monk investigates four-year old murder where the so-called "crazy people" might be the only sane witnesses.
- 6. Mr Monk and the Billionaire Mugger: Things just don't add up for Monk when a billionaire software magnate is shot dead while mugging a couple exiting a movie theater. Is this a mid-life crisis that went too far?

DISC THREE:

- 7. Mr. Monk and the Other Woman: Love is put to the test when Monk falls for a beautiful suspect in the case of a lawyer's murder investigation.
- 8. Mr. Monk and the Marathon Man: Monk's in a race against time to prove that the murderer of a woman who was thrown off a twenty-story balcony was really her lover—even though he was running a marathon at the time.
- 9. Mr. Monk Takes a Vacation: Despite being on a much needed vacation, there's not much rest and relaxation for Monk and Sharona when Benjy claims to have witnessed a murder in their hotel.


DISC FOUR:

- 10. Mr. Monk and the Earthquake: There's more than a force of nature at work when a wealthy businessman is killed during an earthquake, and Monk is sure that the grieving widow had something to do with his calamitous tumble.
- 11. Mr. Monk and the Red-Headed Stranger: Something sounds distinctly off-key when musician Willie Nelson is accused of murdering his embezzling road manager and the only witness to the crime is a blind woman.
- 12. Mr. Monk and the Airplane: Murder takes to the skies when Monk accuses a fellow plane passenger of doing away with his wife and hiding the body somewhere in the airport.

DISC FIVE:

- 1. Mr. Monk and the Actor: It's lights, camera, trouble when a famous actor preparing to play Monk in an upcoming film shadows the detective and becomes too involved with the investigation.
- 2. Mr. Monk and the Garbage Strike: The largest garbage strike in San Francisco history may be prolonged when the union boss is found dead, and it's up to Monk to determine whether the cause of death was suicide or murder.
- 3. Mr. Monk and the Big Game: It's no game when the popular coach of Julie's basketball team dies under strange circumstances, and the girls hire Monk to prove she was really murdered.
- 4. Mr. Monk Can't See a Thing: When Monk loses his eyesight, he must rely on his other senses to help him see the facts of the case and identify the killer.
- 5. Mr. Monk, Private Eye: Natalie convinces Monk to go into business for himself as a private eye, and his first case is a tedious fender—that quickly evolves into a homicide investigation.

Monk Season Two



DISC ONE

- 1. MR. MONK GOES BACK TO SCHOOL: When an English teacher was believed to have committed suicide at Trudy's former high school, the assistant principal called Monk in to investigate. He quickly concludes that it wasn't a suicide based on the suicide note left by the victim. He began to suspect the science teacher, Derek Philby to be the real murderer.
- 2. MR. MONK GOES TO MEXICO: A friend of the mayor asked him to investigate the death of his son in Mexico. He then, sent Monk in to investigate. With all his suitcases stolen, Monk found himself having difficulties concentrating on the case. In the meantime, someone is also trying to kill him.
- 3. MR. MONK GOES TO THE BALLGAME: A CEO, Lawrence Hammond and his pretty young wife are murdered at night in a deserted parking lot. While, Stottlemeyer suspects it to be the doing of the CEO's many enemies, Monk believes that the wife was the real the primary target.
- 4. MR. MONK GOES TO THE CIRCUS: Monk is investigating the death of a sarcastic and unpopular ringmaster who was murdered by an acrobat wearing a face mask and a Ninja-like costume. Monk suspects the ringmaster's ex-wife, a trapeze artist billed as "the Queen of the Sky" who is also a sharpshooter but she has a broken foot.

DISC TWO

- 5. MR. MONK AND THE VERY, VERY OLD MAN: Karen, Captain Stottlemeyer's wife thinks that her documentary subject, the world's oldest man has been murdered. The captain calls Monk in to investigate. After being thrown out of the house by his wife, the captain has no choice but to stay in Monk's place.
- 6. MR. MONK GOES TO THE THEATER: Sharona's sister, Gail who is an actress, is suspected of murdering Hal Duncan, another fellow actor. Apparently, he died after Gail stabs him onstage with what she insists is a retractable knife. Monk begins to suspect that Jenna Ryan, Gail's understudy is the real culprit behind the murder.
- 7. MR. MONK AND THE SLEEPING SUSPECT: Monk suspects that the person behind the mail bombing which killed the rich and beautiful Amanda Babbage is the victim's brother, Brian. However he has been in a coma for four months after getting involved in a car chase with the police.
- 8. MR. MONK MEETS THE PLAYBOY: A secretary hired Monk to investigate the murder of her boss, Elliott D'Souza. She suspected that the playboy/publisher Dexter Larsen is real murderer. Monk suddenly tries to withdraw from the case when Larsen threatens him with nude photographs of Sharona.


DISC THREE

- 9. MR. MONK AND THE 12TH MAN: Captain Stottlemeyer calls in Monk to help him investigate a series of brutal murders. At first, they all suspected Henry Smalls, an insurance agent whose calendars appear in three of the victims' photographs to be the muderer, but then he too became a victim.
- 10. MR. MONK AND THE PAPERBOY: Nestor Alverez, Monk's paperboy was murdered on his front doorstep by a newspaper thief. Now, Monk has to put up with all the police in his house as everyone assumes that the murderer is really after him.
- 11. MR. MONK AND THE THREE PIES: Monk's older brother Ambrose, calls him to investigate a case, but both of them have been estranged ever since Ambrose refused to attend Trudy's funeral seven years before. Ambrose suspects that his next-door neighbor, Pat Van Ranken, has murdered his wife.
- 12. MR. MONK AND THE T.V. STAR: Monk suspects Brad Terry, the star in the TV series *Crime Lab S.F.* of murdering his ex-wife so he won't have to share his huge new paychecks with her. However, the actor has a solid alibi. He was with photographers when the victim's screams were heard.

Monk Season Two DISC FOUR

- 13. MR. MONK AND THE MISSING GRANNY: A middle-aged law student Julie Parlo offers to help Monk becomes reinstated as a policeman with the SFPD if he'll help her find her missing grandmother. Stottlemeyer and Disher suspect the former leader of an anti-Vietnam War group from the 1970s to be the kidnapper.
- 14. MR. MONK AND THE CAPTAIN'S WIFE: Captain Stottlemeyer's wife, Karen, is badly injured when her car is struck by a tow truck whose driver has been killed by a sniper. The captain suspects the sleazy union official and his thug to behind the crime, but with Monk around, the real culprit is about to be capture.
- 15. MR. MONK GETS MARRIED: Lt. Disher asked for Monk and Sharona's help when his 58-year-old mother married a 37-year-old antique dealer whom he believes to be a con man. Meanwhile, Dalton Padron with his new bride is a marriage counseling clinic for their honeymoon. Sharona and Monk has to pose as husband and wife and join him at the clinic.
- 16. MR. MONK GOES TO JAIL: A death-row inmate who was waiting to be executed in 45 minutes was murdered. Dale "the Whale" Biederbeck became the main suspect in the inmate's murder. Dale asked Monk to solve the case and he will provide information about Trudy's murder.

Monk: Season Three



DISC ONE

- 1. MR. MONK TAKES MANHATTAN: Monk, Sharona, Lt. Disher and Stottlemeyer go to New York City to follow the leads concerning Trudy's murder which was given by Dale the Whale. However, three people were killed, including the Latvian ambassador to the United Nations when Monk and the rest were checking into their hotel.
- 2. MR. MONK AND THE PANIC ROOM: Monk is called in to investigate the death of a music producer who was shot in the back, chest and his head in a room locked from the inside. In the room, the police found the dead man's pet chimpanzee, Darwin holding the murder weapon in his hand.
- 3. MR. MONK AND THE BLACKOUT: Monk suspects a '90s radical man named Winston Brenner to be connected to the city-wide blackout which resulted in three deaths. However, Brenner is supposed to have died in 1995.
- 4. Mr. Monk Gets Fired: While Monk was investigating a case involving a female victim whose body was cut up with a chainsaw, he accidentally erases several years' worth of crucial computer files. As a result of that, the commissioner revoked Monk's private practice license. Monk struggled to look for a new job.

DISC TWO

- 5. MR. MONK MEETS THE GODFATHER: A mob godfather, Salvatore Lucarelli, hires Monk to investigate the death of five members of the West Coast Mafia during a shoot out in a barbershop. Agent Colmes of the FBI offers Monk the reinstatement on the police force if he helps him to bring down the mafia gang.
- 6. MR. MONK AND THE GIRL WHO CRIED WOLF: Sharona suspects she is suffering from a mental breakdown when she has several frightening encounters with a blood-soaked man that no one seems to believe exists.
- 7. MR. MONK AND THE EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Monk is called in to investigate the death of Edna Coruthers, a model employee at Mega-Mart by the store's security chief, who turns out to be his disgraced ex-partner, Joe Christie. At first, Monk was reluctant to help Christie, however, later he agrees and began to go undercover as a store clerk.
- 8. MR. MONK AND THE GAME SHOW: Trudy's father, Dwight Ellison, pays Monk a visit and invites him to spend the week with him and his wife, Marcia. He also asks Monk to help him to investigate Roddy Lankman, the game show host who seems to be involved in a conspiracy to allow one of his contestants, Val Birch, to win every game.

DISC THREE

- 9. MR. MONK TAKES HIS MEDICINE: Feeling depressed and helpless after Captain Stottlemeyer is shot by an unknown assailant, Monk decides to try a new medication that eliminates his phobias. But it also makes him unbearably egotistical.
- 10. MR. MONK AND THE RED HERRING: Sharona has remarried her ex-husband and moved to New Jersey, Monk still can't t find a new assistant after three months. Meanwhile, Natalie Teeger who is a widow with an eleven-year-old daughter, kills an intruder in her house in self defense. She is baffled as this is the second time someone broke into her house in the past few days. Captain Stottlemeyer suggests she go to Monk for help.
- 11. MR. MONK VS. THE COBRA: John Ricca, an author of a controversial and unfavorable biography of martial artist Sonny Chow, is found murdered in his home and all the evidence seems to point to



Sonny as the murderer. However, Sonny has been dead for six years. Meanwhile, Monk disagrees with Natalie regarding the reimbursement of her expenses.

12. MR. MONK GETS CABIN FEVER: Monk witnesses a Chinese mob killing and is forced to take refuge in an FBI safe house out in the forest. After hearing a man screaming, Monk is convinced a murder has taken place nearby - but the agent assigned to protect him isn't so sure.

- 13. MR. MONK GETS STUCK IN TRAFFIC: Monk, Natalie, and Julie are stuck in a traffic jam after a multi-car collision blocks the freeway. Monk got out of the car to investigate and discovers that the man in the overturned Volkswagen that caused the collision was murdered and didn't die from the accident. His body was placed in the car in order to make his death look like an accident.
- 14. MR. MONK GOES TO VEGAS: Monk receives a call from a drunken Stottlemeyer, who is in Las Vegas with Disher for a fellow officer's bachelor party. Stottlemeyer suspects that the casino owner has murdered his wife. However, when Monk and Natalie arrive in Vegas the very next day, Stottlemeyer can't remember anything that happened the previous night.
- 15. MR. MONK AND THE ELECTION: Natalie becomes a candidate in the upcoming school board election due to her daughter's school being closed as a cost-cutting measure. A sniper fires into her campaign headquarters, killing a security guard and left an oddly folded note demanding that *Natalie Teege* withdraw from the election.
- 16. MR. MONK AND THE KID: A 22 month old toddler, Tommy Graser, finds a severed finger and gives it to a policeman. Monk is called in to investigate and together with Tommy, they walk through the park, trying to retrace the small child's steps.

Monk: Season Four



DISC ONE

- 1. MR. MONK AND THE OTHER DETECTIVE: Monk has finally found someone who is as great a detective he is. Marty Eels managed to identify one of the killers who murdered a jewelry store owner, Harold Gumbal, by only using the dog poo and the dog as clues. But is the new detective as good as he looks?
- 2. MR. MONK GOES HOME AGAIN: Monk's brother Ambrose is alone with Natalie, while Monk has to investigate shooting involving an armored car driver. Meanwhile, a man dressed as Frankenstein's monster steals candy from the children trick-or-treating with

Julie. Somehow, these two incidents are related.

- 3. MR. MONK STAYS IN BED: Monk is down with the flu and Julie is left with the task of watching him while Natalie decides to investigate the death of a pizza delivery man.
- 4. MR. MONK GOES TO THE OFFICE: When financial analyst Warren Kemp is attacked by an unknown assailant, he hires Monk to investigate. Kemp suspects the assailant is one of his employees, so Monk has to go undercover as an office worker.

DISC TWO

- 5. MR. MONK GETS DRUNK: Monk meets a stranger named Larry Zwibell at the wine-country inn where he and Trudy spent their honeymoon. However, the next morning, nobody seems to remember this person. His name is not in the hotel registry and another person is in his assigned room.
- 6. MR. MONK AND MRS. MONK: Natalie stumbles upon a woman named Trudy, who looks exactly like Monk's late wife, and confides in Stottlemeyer. When another man, Zach Ellinghouse, who was seen with Trudy was murdered, Monk is called in to investigate.
- 7. MR. MONK GOES TO A WEDDING: Lt. Disher is ran down by a car and seriously injured while at Natalie's brother's rehearsal dinner. Meanwhile, the wedding photographer has disappeared and Captain Stottlemeyer goes undercover as his replacement and Monk comes along to help the captain.
- 8. MR. MONK AND LITTLE MONK: When a childhood crush comes to Monk with a mysterious murder, Monk tries to win her heart by solving the case.

DISC THREE


- 9. MR. MONK AND THE SECRET SANTA: It is Christmas time in San Francisco, but all is not merry. A cop is dead after drinking a poisoned bottle of wine intended for Captain Stottlemeyer, and while all leads point to a man with a grudge against the Captain, Monk isn't convinced. With Natalie's help, Monk does some of his own detective work, which soon finds him caroling, fighting off crowds at the mall... and even doing some undercover work as a certain jolly, red-suited fellow. Will Monk solve the baffling crime in time to enjoy the holidays?
- 10. MR. MONK GOES TO A FASHION SHOW: Monk dives into the world of fashion when he tracks down his favorite shirt inspector to find out why she hasn't been doing her job and discovers that her son is in jail for murdering a model.

Monk: Season Four

- 11. MR. MONK BUMPS HIS HEAD: After he is attacked and knocked unconscious by a man who claimed to have information on Trudy's death, Monk wakes up with amnesia in a small town. Without a dollar in his pocket, he wanders around town trying to remember who is, until he meets an eccentric woman who claims to be his wife. As Monk tries to adjust to his new life, he learns that a friendly waitress he met in a diner has disappeared. After a little bit of investigation, he is able to determine that she was murdered, but nobody in town will believe him. Meanwhile, back in San Francisco, Natalie, Stottlemeyer and Disher are frantically trying to piece together what happened in an attempt to locate Monk.
- 12. MR. MONK AND THE CAPTAIN'S MARRIAGE: When a cop claims to be seeing his wife behind his back, Captain Stottlemeyer loses his temper and punches him in the face. Because of this, he is forced to take an anger management course as a way to learn how to control his temper. When confronted about the situation, his wife is offended that her husband would ever believe such an obvious lie. Even though she denies all the accusations, Captain Stottlemeyer recruits Monk and Natalie to follow his wife around town and see what she's up to. What neither of them realize, is that this entire situation is tied to the mysterious murder case that they're working on.

- 13. MR. MONK AND THE BIG REWARD: Monk and Natalie are investigating a diamond heist. The only thing that makes this case different than the others they've investigated, is the fact that reward money is being offered to whoever solves the case. Becuase of this, Monk and Natalie have to deal with many distractions caused by others who want to solve the case themselves.
- 14. MR. MONK AND THE ASTRONAUT: When a woman is found dead in her home, all signs point to suicide. However, Captain Stottlemeyer has reason to believe otherwise and calls in for Monk's opinion. Monk agrees that this was definitely a murder, and after a little investigating, he believes the killer to be an astronaut. The only problem with Monk's lead suspect is that he wasn't even on the planet at the time of the murder; he was out in space. Monk, still certain that he's the guy, must figure out how to prove to everyone that it was in fact him, despite his airtight alibi.
- 15. MR. MONK GOES TO THE DENTIST: While under sedation in the dentist's chair, Disher is certain that he saw the dentist and his assistant murder a man. However, he has trouble getting people to believe him, as they all think that he probably imagined it. He then pays a visit to Monk and asks him to look into it for him. Despite his huge fear of dentists, Monk agrees to investigate Disher's claims and after some digging, he realizes that the dentist might actually be tied to a crime that took place earlier.
- 16. MR. MONK GETS JURY DUTY: Mr. Monk is upset to learn that he has been called for jury duty. Although he tries to get out of it, he doesn't succeed and winds up being Juror #11 on a robbery trial. Upon listening to the facts and the evidence, all the jurors unanimously vote "guilty." All the jurors, that is, except for Monk. He feels that the evidence doesn't add up, and its up to him to convince the jurors to reconsider. However, he soon learns that he has bigger problems to deal with when a dead body is found in the courthouse dumpster.


Monk: Season Five



DISC ONE

- 1. MR. MONK AND THE ACTOR: A famous actor preparing to play Monk gets a little too close to one of Monk's real-life murder investigations.
- 2. MR. MONK AND THE GARBAGE STRIKE: When a union boss's death threatens to prolong a city-wide garbage strike in San Francisco, it's up to Monk to help end the strike by determining whether the boss' death was suicide or murder
- 3. MR. MONK AND THE BIG GAME: Julie and her friends hire Monk to look into the suspicious death of their basketball coach.
- 4. Mr. Monk Can't See a Thing: Monk tries to solve a murder after losing his eyesight.
- 5. MR. MONK, PRIVATE EYE: When Natalie convinces Monk to go into business as a private eye, his first case is a seemingly innocuous fender bender that leads to a far more dangerous investigation. Introduces story arc with Capt. Stottlemeyer's girlfriend.
- 6. MR. MONK AND THE CLASS REUNION: Monk attends his college reunion and uncovers a complex murder plot against one of his former classmates.
- 7. MR. MONK GETS A NEW SHRINK: When Dr. Kroger retires after his cleaning lady is killed, it's up to Monk to solve the case and get Dr. Kroger back to work.
- 8. MR. MONK GOES TO A ROCK CONCERT: Monk goes to a rock concert to look for Captain Stottlemeyer's son and finds himself in the middle of a murder investigation.
- 9. MR. MONK MEETS HIS DAD: When Monk's truck driving father rolls into town at Christmas time, Monk joins him on the road, where they stumble across a very peculiar mystery.
- 10. MR. MONK AND THE LEPER: A missing billionaire suffering from leprosy comes out of hiding to hire Monk, who soon finds himself in the midst of a shadowy murder plot worthy of a classic Hollywood film noir. The episode was broadcast in black & white as well as in color. Both versions are included in the DVD release.
- 11. MR. MONK MAKES A FRIEND: A fun-loving everyman named Hal bumps into Monk, and the two become fast friends. For the first time in his life, Monk appears to have a buddy. But is Hal up to something?
- 12. MR. MONK IS AT YOUR SERVICE: When Natalie suspects foul play in the deaths of her parents' wealthy neighbors, Monk goes undercover as a butler to investigate.
- 13. MR. MONK IS ON THE AIR: Monk goes toe to toe with a popular radio shock jock who is suspected of killing his wife.
- 14. MR. MONK VISITS A FARM: When Lt. Disher inherits a farm from an uncle who committed suicide, he decides to quit the police force and start a new life in the country. But Disher soon suspects that his uncle was murdered, so Monk joins him on the farm to investigate.
- 15. MR. MONK AND THE REALLY, REALLY DEAD GUY: When the mysterious "Six Way Killer" strikes in San Francisco, Monk matches his detective skills against the flashy forensic technology of a federal agent as they both pursue the murderer.
- 16. MR. MONK GOES TO THE HOSPITAL: Monk goes to the emergency room for a bloody nose, but when a doctor in the hospital turns up dead, Monk joins the murder investigation, and soon his own life is in grave danger.

DISC ONE

- 1. MR. MONK AND HIS BIGGEST FAN: Marci Maven (Sarah Silverman) returns, having been accused of murder.
- 2. MR. MONK AND THE RAPPER: Rapper Murderess (Snoop Dogg) is accused of whacking another rapper, and it's up to Monk to take the case.
- 3. MR. MONK AND THE NAKED MAN: Monk has to confront his prejudice against nudists when he is called in to investigate a murder on a nude beach.
- 4. MR. MONK AND THE BAD GIRLFRIEND: Monk's friendship with Captain Stottlemeyer is put to the test when Monk suspects the captain's girlfriend of murder.

DISC TWO


- 5. MR. MONK AND THE BIRDS AND THE BEES: Monk tries to prove a sports agent is guilty of murder while helping Natalie's teenage daughter, Julie, with her love life.
- 6. MR. MONK AND THE BURIED TREASURE: Monk digs up trouble when he is tricked into helping three teens follow a treasure map.
- 7. MR. MONK AND THE DAREDEVIL: Monk gets depressed when he finds out that Harold Krenshaw is the Frisco Fly, a real-life Human Fly.
- 8. MR. MONK AND THE WRONG MAN: A man whom Monk convicted and sent to jail of a double homicide fourteen years ago is exonerated by DNA evidence.

DISC THREE

- 9. MR. MONK STAYS UP ALL NIGHT: When Monk suffers from insomnia, he ventures into the night and stumbles upon a murder.
- 10. MR. MONK AND THE MAN WHO SHOT SANTA CLAUS: Monk becomes a social outcast when he shoots a man dressed as Santa Claus. He then must clear his name and prevent a larger criminal plot, before Christmas.
- 11. MR. MONK JOINS A CULT: When Monk infiltrates a cult to solve a murder, he falls under the spell of its charismatic leader (Howie Mandel).
- 12. MR. MONK GOES TO THE BANK: When the safety deposit box holding one of Monk's treasured possessions is robbed, Monk will do whatever it takes to solve the case.

- 13. MR. MONK AND THE THREE JULIES: Monk must find a murderer who, to Natalie's horror, appears to be killing women with the same name as her daughter.
- 14. MR. MONK PAINTS HIS MASTERPIECE: Monk takes up a new hobby painting and meets with unexpected success. This is the last episode that Stanley Kamel (Dr. Kroger) appears in. He died on April 8th, 2008
- 15. MR. MONK IS ON THE RUN: PART 1: Arrested for murder, Monk escapes a small-town sheriff's custody and becomes a fugitive.
- 16. MR. MONK IS ON THE RUN: PART 2: While everyone mourns Monk's "death", he searches for the truth that will clear his name.

DISC ONE

- 1. MR. MONK BUYS A HOUSE: When a noisy neighbor forces Monk to move, he ends up in a new house with an overeager handyman. This episode ends with a shot of Dr. Kroger's photo, and a "In Loving Memory of" message to Stanley Kamel, who died April 8, 2008.
- 2. MR. MONK AND THE GENIUS: Monk pits his wits against a grandmaster chess player with murder on his mind.
- 3. MR. MONK GETS LOTTO FEVER: Natalie becomes a Lotto Girl for the California lottery, but when she becomes embroiled in a scandal Monk comes to her aid.
- 4. MR. MONK TAKES A PUNCH: While investigating a murder, Monk is forced to consider giving up his dream of being reinstated to the police... and takes a job as a boxer's cornerman.

DISC TWO


- 5. MR. MONK IS UNDERWATER: Monk is put in an uncomfortable position when a friend of Natalie's ex-husband asks him to help solve the apparent suicide of a friend.
- 6. MR. MONK FALLS IN LOVE: Monk is smitten with an attractive Zemenian woman who works at a refugee center. When she's accused of murder, he agrees to help her... despite the fact she confessed to the crime.

- 11. MR. MONK ON WHEELS: While investigating the theft of a bicycle, Monk is shot and Natalie soon finds her boss more demanding than ever.
- 12. MR. MONK AND THE LADY NEXT DOOR: While investigating a murder at a museum, Monk befriends a neighbor lady but begins to suspect her when he wonders why anyone would want to be his friend.

- 13. MR. MONK MAKES THE PLAYOFFS: Thanks to Bob Costas, Monk has tickets to a big playoff game and invites Stottlemeyer along, but soon becomes embroiled in a murder investigation.
- 14. MR. MONK AND THE BULLY: The bully that picked on Monk as a boy has grown up and needs the detective to follow his wife and determine if she's having an affair. Monk is more than happy to follow the woman and hopes to prove his old nemesis right.
- 15. MR. MONK AND THE MAGICIAN: When a friend of Monk's is killed, Monk believes that a magician is responsible and a battle of wits and sleight-of-hand ensue.
- 16. MR. MONK FIGHTS CITY HALL: When the parking garage where Monk's wife was killed is set for demolition, Monk intervenes but soon finds himself investigating the disappearance of a city official key to preserving the site.

- 2. MR. MONK AND THE FOREIGN MAN While investigating the case of a murdered maid with an unusual solicitous killer, Monk meets an African widower looking for the killer of his wife.
- 3. MR. MONK AND THE UFO Monk and Natalie are stranded in a small desert town and the detective spots a UFO. He soon discovers himself the center of attention, and is called in to investigate a dead woman discovered in the desert
- 4. MR. MONK IS SOMEONE ELSE Monk assumes a dead hit man's identity in order to foil an assassination plot.

DISC TWO

- 5. MR. MONK TAKES THE STAND Monk's phobias prove a liability when he must testify against a killer in court.
- 6. MR. MONK AND THE CRITIC Natalie suspects a theater critic is responsible for a murder, despite the fact that he was present to review her daughter Julie's play at the same time the victim died.
